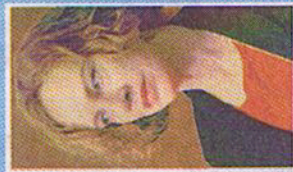


## Three things I know about Judy Davis

# Cameron's Sydney sub design

Film director James Cameron last night took out the nation's most prestigious design award at the Australian International Design Awards in Sydney. The *Avatar* and *Titanic* filmmaker had 40 of his creative collaborators with him when he flew from Melbourne yesterday to attend last night's awards at The Ivy Ballroom.

Cameron picked up the award for his *Deepsea Challenger* Research Submersible

design, which was designed and manufactured by four Australian companies. The *Deepsea Challenger*, built in Leichhardt, is the first single-occupant research submersible vehicle capable of safely transporting a human 11km below sea level to the bottom of the ocean.

It is a subject that has

captivated Cameron, who also directed deep sea thriller *The Abyss*, for much of his filmmaking career.

The judges remarked that the design was: "A stunning use of design at the highest order — incredible, inspirational, a total game changer."

Cameron flew to Sydney yesterday morning after spend-

ing part of week in Melbourne reviewing the submersible's recent endeavours. He and his team were in fine fettle last night at The Ivy's celebration after-party.

The design awards also recognise architectural and interior products, automotive, business technology, housing and building, medical and scientific, service design and sport.

Cameron's Submersible was the winner of the Heavy Machinery category.
